

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jon Neal at 6:05 PM.

**Treasurer report:** Marlene Barker reported that we have started over with new funds for the current year. As we are on year three of our grant cycle. We have a few outstanding invoices. Safe Sitters for 1,023.16, Coffee sleeves for 799.47, the sign at the tennis courts for 702.00 and some Paxis Institute bills for training and kits, that we have not received yet.

**Community Celebration/carnival:** The celebration was held October 5 on the north side of Oroville High School on Homecoming night and was a huge success. We collected \$500.00 which means there were 5,000 tickets sold for the kids to play carnival games and play in the bouncy houses. A huge thanks to Marlene for her outstanding organizing and ideas and all the workers for putting it together and manning the booths...it was agreed that we will do it again next year with even more games and activities.

**Parenting Love and Logic:** JoAnn reported that six to eight people have committed to participate in the first classes. This will be a soft start for facilitators before we begin with Truancy Board and court mandated attendees. We would like to have Orlando/Family Health Centers offer a Spanish class soon.

**PAX Update:** Teachers at the Elementary School, except in third grade, music and lifeskills, have been trained in PAX and are implementing. We will train paras next year.

**Safe Sitter:** School nurse, Karen McNair agreed to teach the first class. November 17th will be the first class and she can take up to 8 students. The class is full at this time.

**Jingle Bell Jog:** Jodie Evens and Steffi Fuchs expressed interest in organizing, coordinating and advertising the activity. Their hours would count toward in-kind volunteer match. This would help us in our goal to involve the community in getting things going for the kids. Some ideas put forth were to ask the family health centers to provide pedometers for the participants, sponsorships ....maybe have the run start at Hwy 7 and end at the park for the tree lighting.

**Trunk or Treat:** will be held at Aikins/ Country Store parking lot on October 31<sup>st</sup>. Traci will be gone, but said that anyone interested could use her supplies from last year. It would be nice if we could have representation there, but it wont be as an organized Coalition activity.

**Neptune:** It's a broadcast program that would play our ads at every school sporting event, morning message and other activities. Jon made the motion we purchase advertising with Neptune at school- Walt seconded .... Motion passed.

**Smoke free sign** – Department of Health – Marijuana PSA can be used – Region wants smoke & marijuana free zones in park. /smoking, vaping, e-cigs. We must take it to City Council first. Readdress at Wednesday's committee meeting
